The Big Scream is a massive community project which is run, managed and delivered by a community led steering group.

Despite the ongoing challenges of Covid, everyone has been working together to make this year's festival happen.

The lead-up to the festival has included interaction with more than thirty schools, childcare, after-school and youth services involving hundreds of children and young people. Apart from enjoying story-telling and Halloween quizzes with our festival Dracula, they have been exploring the origins of Halloween with Dublin City Council's Historian in Residence, Mary Muldowney. Meanwhile, the Scream Team have been busy delivery sweets and prizes around the NEIC.

Young people have made scary props and they've also produced very spooky Halloween films. As always, special effects workshops are in huge demand and there has been a great response to our online challenges including Halloween art, make-up, stories and jokes. Youth services are almost finished their 6-week programmes to entertain and educate young people about harm reduction around Halloween traditions. And besides all that, there's been lots more going on behind the scenes. Now, we're looking forward to four days of festival fun which will be very different than other years, but we hope there will be something for everyone to enjoy.

On Halloween itself, the Scream Team will be travelling around the community to bring you Trick O' Treats and Halloween cheer so no need to leave home, we'll come to you.


