RECRUITMENT OF LOCAL RESEARCHERS - APPLICATION FORM

1. INTRODUCTION

The North East Inner City (NEIC) Initiative has contracted Stephen Rourke to assist in the production of an Action Plan for the areas around Liberty Park. Stephen is an experienced social researcher. An important part of the process of producing the Action Plan will be a survey of local residents so as to get their views, opinions and suggestions in relation to the areas around Liberty Park. This survey will involve the production of a questionnaire and getting as many local people as possible to complete this questionnaire.

Stephen Rourke will work closely with a team of 6 local researchers who will each be allocated 150/250 housing units and their job will be get the maximum number of questionnaires completed - either with the direct assistance of the local researcher or through the questionnaire being completed by residents in their own time and then collected afterwards by the local researcher. Residents can also send completed questionnaires to Stephen Rourke and drop off completed questionnaires in designated drop-off spots.

The survey will take place between January 2020 and April 2020. The research team (comprising Stephen Rourke and the 6 local researchers) will meet every 3 weeks to review progress and to plan ahead. People interested in becoming one of the 6 local researchers should complete this application form and return it to Stephen Rourke by Tuesday 7th January 2020. 
